<p>Thames Lighters – The Workhorses of London’s Watery Highway Talk by Alun Thomas Thursday 25 July 19:30 at Honeywood Museum</p> <p>Until the early 1960s the River Thames was thronged with vessels of all shapes and sizes bringing goods to London. Of these, lighters were the most numerous although the most insignificant in appearance. They played a vital role in moving cargos from ship to shore and from dock to upriver wharf. These unique vessels had no means of propulsion beyond the ingress and egress of the tide.
