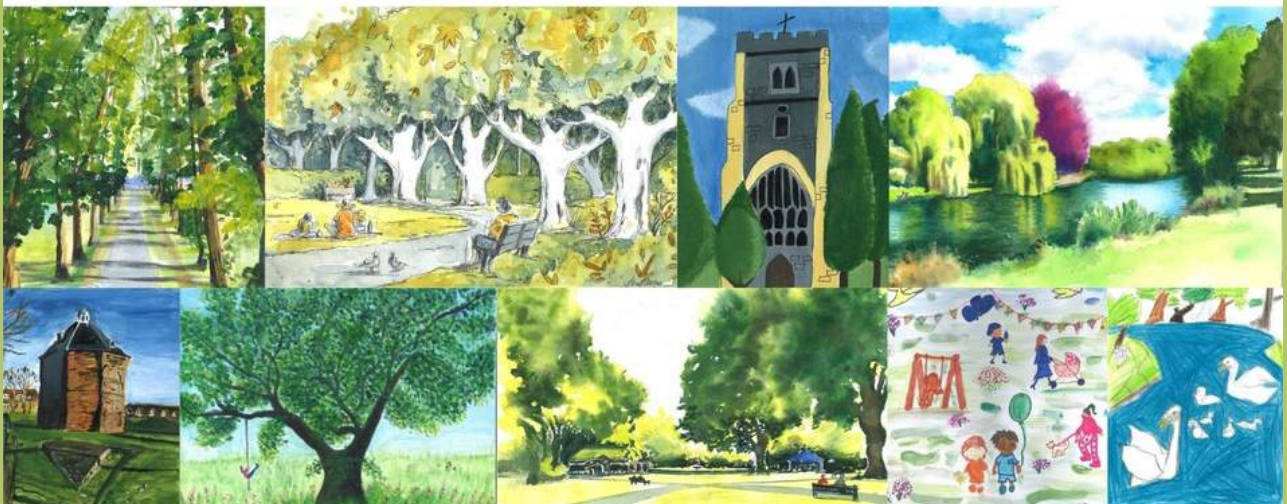

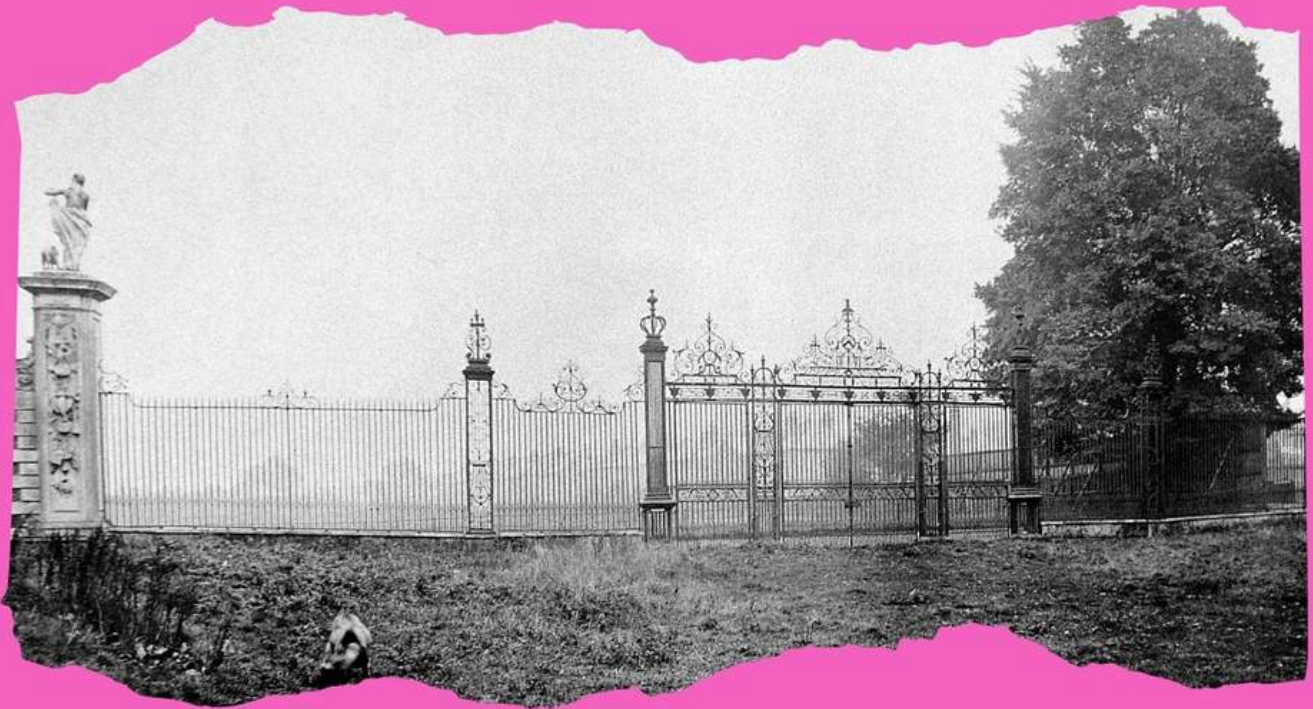

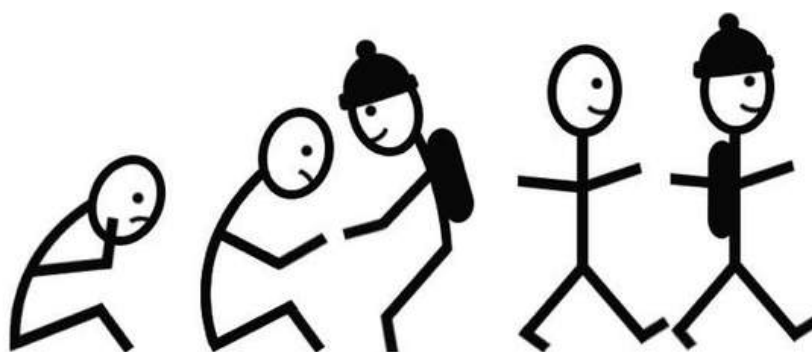

Each dinosaur is animated with robotic moving parts, which include arms moving, tails swaying side to side, heads moving up and down, eyes blinking, jaws opening wide with realistic roaring sound effects. Making for a truly awesome walk- through experience!

This mesmerising experience is as educational as it is entertaining and the perfect day out for children and adults. Visitors will walk a perilous path through grasslands and woodlands and come face- to - face with snarling, roaring and hissing dinosaurs amongst the trees, bushes and woods.
